PAU GOLF CLUB

2

- Pau Golf Club founded in 1856
- Lady's Club opened in 1877
- Most probably by British military veterans of the Pyrenees expedition lead by Wellington against the French army of Napoleon during the Iberian war
- Initially fairly dormant but very active in the last two decades of the 19th century
- Pau became a centre of British socialites active in popular pastimes and leisure activities during the winter period – Le Cercle Anglais de Pau founded in 1827

- Group portraits made by Major Francis Powell
- “Shortspoon” Hopkins (1830-1913), and
- Allen Culpepper Sealy (1850-1927)
- Hopkins and Sealy both being golfers and active members of PGC regularly visiting Pau
- Hopkins 1880’s
- Sealy 1890’s

- Hopkins commissioned by the club to make a large group portrait in 1884 similar to the Royal Blackheath and the Royal North Devon paintings
- All PGC golfers named in keylist and identified
- Blackheath and North Devon golfers also known from keylists with names

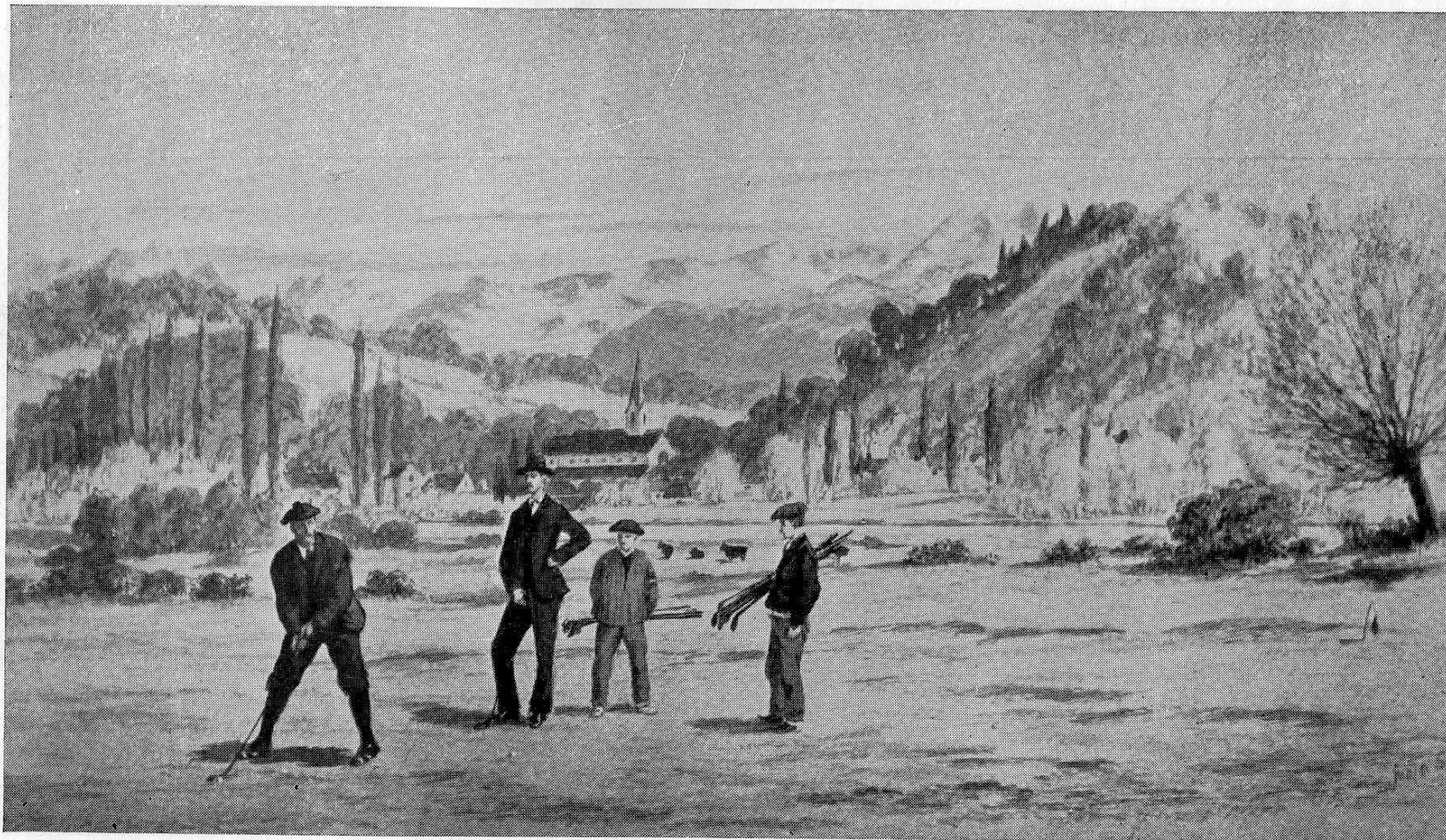

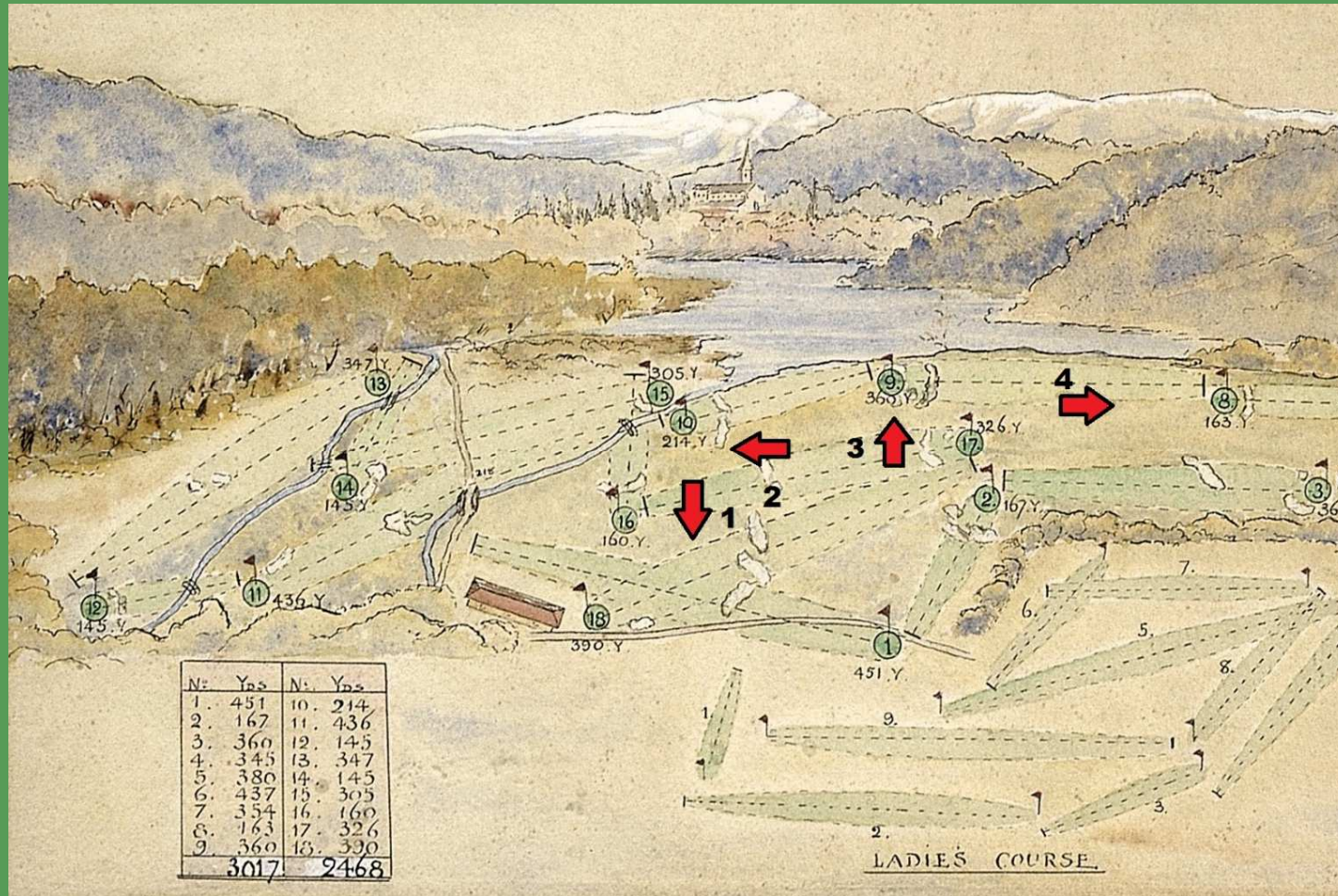

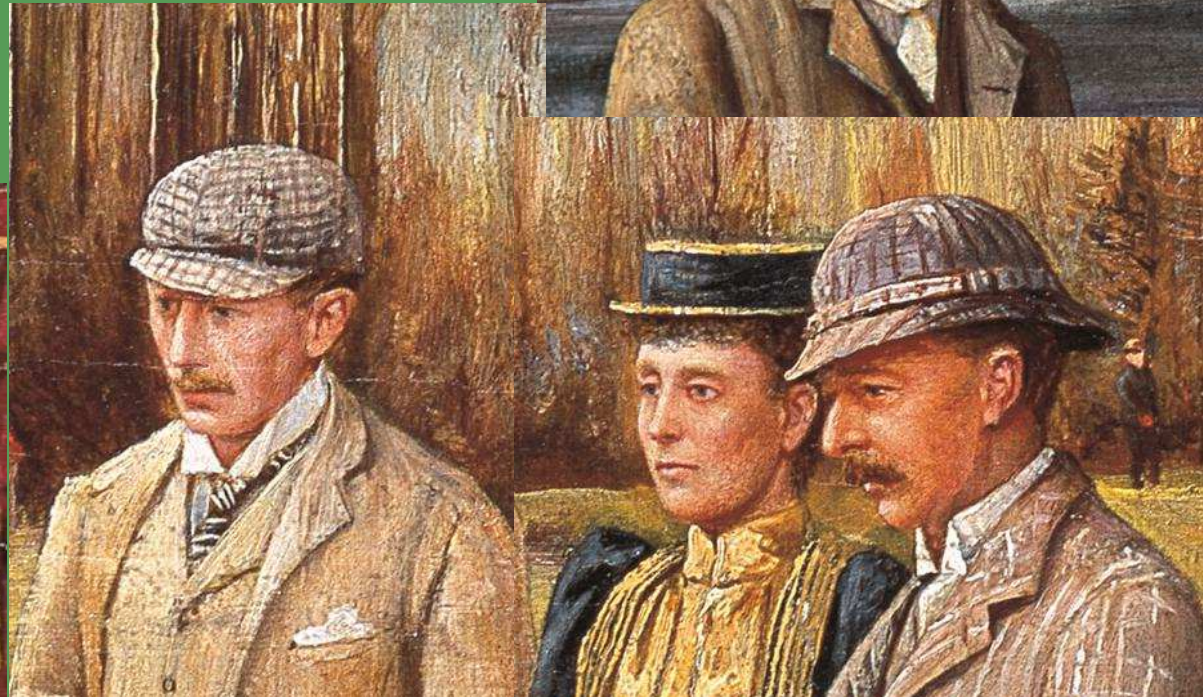
